Ash Wednesday, February 14, 2024

Catholics receive the mark of ashes on their foreheads as a sign of the call to penance as the Season of Lent opens. Through prayer, fasting, and works of charity, we journey through these forty days to glory of Easter.

Days of Fasting and Penance

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence from meat for Catholics. The rules for fasting apply to those Catholics – in good health – between the ages of 14 and 59. The law of abstinence from meat applies to all Catholics. A good work of charity may substitute either fasting or abstinence. Fridays of Lent, in Canada, are days of fast and abstinence. Those who can fast and abstain are encouraged to do so.

9:00 a.m. & 11:00 a.m.

The Lord is Risen indeed! With joyful singing and celebration, we proclaim that we are a resurrection people and Alleluia is our song! The Easter Season continues for 50 days until the Solemnity of Pentecost on May 19.
